QC opens new laboratories, auditorium in university

MAYOR Herbert Bautista led the inauguration of a newly constructed seven-story building in Quezon City University.

The building consists of 33 laboratories and a 500-seater auditorium on the seventh floor which will cater to the 8,600 students of the university.

The ground floor of the structure will also serve as an 'incubation facility' of BS Entrepreneur students.

The city-owned university has another seven-story academic building under construction and two other buildings under-



going renovation.

QCU (formerly known as the Quezon City Polytechnic University) offers five four-year degree programs including BS Entrepreneur, BS Information Technology, BS Electrical Engineering, BS Industrial Engineering, and BS Accountancy.
