

QC gov't forms 80th Foundation Day Committee

MAYOR Joy Belmonte ordered the creation of the 80th Foundation Day Committee to ensure the successful Ruby Jubilee celebration of the city in October.

Executive Order No. 21 tasks the QC 80th Foundation Day Committee to facilitate the preparation and execution of the historic month-long activities.

The special committee is composed of the city mayor as the honorary chairperson, the vice mayor as the honorary vice-chairman, the city administrator as the chairman, the chief of staff of the Office of the City Mayor, and the action officer of QC Tourism Department as co-vice chairmans.

The sub-committee on programs and events are composed of the heads

of the Barangay and Community Relations Department, Business Permits and Licensing Department, Social Services Development Department, Parks Development and Administration Department, Human Resources Management Department, and the Schools Division Superintendent.

Executive Order No. 21 also orders the creation of the 2019 Manuel L. Quezon Gawad Parangal Award selection board.

The annual award honors the significant contributions of individuals and institutions in QC in various fields.

The Manuel L. Quezon Gawad Parangal awarding ceremony is traditionally a part of QC's founding anniversary celebrations.
