QC male restrooms install partitions

In the interests of public health, a resolution has been filed before the Quezon City Council urging establishments to install partitions between urinals in male restrooms throughout the city.

In City Resolution 7845–2019, introduced by Councilor Eric Medina, all business owners, proprietors and managers should comply with QC Ordinance 1313–2003 requiring urinary bowl partitions in male toilets.

"The purpose of the said partition between urinary bowls in the toilets is to prevent or avoid nuisance, utter interference with one's privacy, and protect public health," the resolution reads.

The resolution urged the Business Permits and Licensing Department and the Quezon City Health Department to ensure that the panels are installed in male restrooms throughout the city.
