

QC HONORS 30 VILLAGES FOR SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT EFFORTS

THE Task Force on Solid Waste Collection, Cleaning and Disposal Services Management of Quezon City has recently recognized the efforts of 30 barangay (villages) in strictly enforcing the city's solid waste management program. "Ibinibigaynglungso-dangawardsamgabarangaydahilmalakiangnagingpapelnmganamumunoatng kani-lang pamayanan sa tagumpay ng solid waste management effort sa QC (The city government is giving the villages this recognition for their efforts in the solid waste management in QC)," the Task Force's action officer Richard Santuile said. The awardees for Best Barangay with Ecological Solid Waste Management Program were the villages of Talayan, Philam, Sto. Cristo, Holy Spirit, Commonwealth, Batasan Hills, Blue Ridge A, Blue Ridge B, St. Ignatius, Paligsahan, Pinagkaisahan, Mariana, San Bartolome, Kaligayahan and Culiat.

Meanwhile, the villages cited for their strict enforcement of the city's Mandatory Waste Segregation at Source Policy were West Triangle, Nayong Kanluran, Milagrosa, Escopa 4, Doña Aurora, Valencia, Santol, Bagbag, Greater Lagro and Talipapa. These villages were compliant in sorting out residual, biodegradable and recyclable wastes.
