QC-operated hospitals feted

The Philippine Hospital Association has recognized two hospitals operated by the Quezon City government as among the most outstanding hospitals of the country. The Novaliches District Hospital (NDH) and the Quezon City General Hospital (QCGH) were recognized during the awarding ceremony held at the Manila Hotel last week, the city government said in a statement yesterday.

The two hospitals were cited for their outstanding contributions to the field of best practices for excellence in healthcare.

They were the only hospitals operated by a local government unit that were recognized by the association.

NDH was chosen as the Most Outstanding Level 1 Government Hospital, while the QCGH was recognized as one of the Outstanding Level 3 Government Hospitals in the country, joining others operated by the Department of Health.

Quezon City has three hospitals operated by the local government unit, with the latest – the Rosario Maclang Bautista General Hospital in Barangay Batasan Hills – opening last year.
