## QC 'discipline zone' on dry run

Quezon City police are implementing "discipline zones" in the city as a way to deter the commission of crimes and enforce compliance in local communities. Quezon City Police District (QCPD) acting director Brig. Gen. Ronnie Montejo said violators of laws and ordinances will be apprehended in the discipline zones of Cubao, West Avenue, Katipunan Avenue, Timog Avenue Tomas Morato area, and Novaliches proper. The scheme will have its dry run to day. Montejo said over the week end that the establishment of zones will oblige people to observe order.

"All city ordinances, special laws, criminal laws will be implemented there with out fear or favor. Those who will be caught violating the law will be charged and imprisoned, while minors will be turned over to the (City Social Welfare Department)," Montejo said. The police official said the QCPD discipline zone project is supported by the city government led by Mayor Joy Belmonte who vowed to provide manpower from different departments to help in manning traffic and apprehending violators of city ordinances.
