ORDINANCE NO. SP-2887, S-2019

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING THREE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP3,000.00) ADDITIONAL INCENTIVE TO ALL JOB ORDER (JO) AND CONTRACT OF SERVICE (COS) EMPLOYEES OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT TO BE TAKEN FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, in 2018, the City granted additional incentive to employees of the Quezon City Government through Ordinance No. SP-2792, S-2018;

WHEREAS, with the sound financial management of the City, it is high time that the salaries of employees must be taken into consideration;

WHEREAS, due to the increase in the prices of basic commodities, the grant of additional incentive to all Quezon City Government employees is imperative.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN
REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. An additional Three Thousand Pesos (Php3,000.00) incentive is hereby granted to all Job Order (JO) and Contract of Service (COS) Employees of the Quezon City Government.

SECTION 2. The amount necessary to cover this additional incentive is hereby appropriated to be taken from any available funds of the City.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


