Quezon City police donate P250K for Taal victims

The Quezon City Police District donated cash worth P250,000 for the victims of the Taal Volcano. Heeding the call of Philippine National Police (PNP) chief PLt. Gen. Archie Gamboa for the police force to donate P10 for the Taal victims, QCPD director PBrig. Gen. Ronnie Montejo said he and his men donated the initial amount. Montejo said, "This is our way of helping our brothers and sisters, especially those who were displaced by the eruption of Taal Volcano. No one else will help and console them in this time of calamity."

The QCPD chief said the amount was delivered last Friday to National Capital Region Police Office (NCRPO) acting regional director PBrig. Gen. Debold Sinas at Camp Bagong Diwa, Taguig City, who will arrange for the turnover of the amount to the victims. Montejo said the amount was taken from the voluntary contribution of QCPD personnel from their city stipend.

Aside from the P250,000 donation, they expect to donate additional cash, as Sinas called upon NCRPO personnel to donate at least P100 instead of P10 for the Taal Volcano victims.
