

QC reports no new COVID cases

Quezon City, one of the cities in Metro Manila hardest hit by the coronavirus disease 2019, reported no new cases of COVID-19 over the weekend.

The local government said the number of COVID-19 patients in the city stood at 1,104, with no new cases as of 11 p.m. on Saturday.

Of the number, 960 are residents of Quezon City.

The health department also tallied nine new recoveries, bringing to 142 the number of recovered cases.

There were 12 new reported deaths for a total of 118 fatalities.

The city government has been conducting communitybased testing for residents, with over 1,800 swab tests done since April 13. –
