QCPD HQ on lockdown as 14 cops test COVID-positive

The main headquarters of the Quezon City Police District (QCPD), Camp Karingal, was placed under a three-day lockdown after 14 of its personnel assigned in the area tested positive for the coronavirus disease (COVID-19).

Maj. Gen. Debold Sinas, director of the National Capital Region Police Office (NCRPO), said that the number of infected personnel at the QCPD calls for immediate measures to prevent the spread of the disease.

A five-day testing was conducted for personnel of the QCPD recently wherein 219 were subjected to COVID19 tests.

Of the 115 results that were released, 14 of them tested positive, four of them are police commissioned-officers.

Ten of those who tested positive are presently assigned at the District Headquarters in Camp Karingal, Quezon City. The four other patients are assigned at QCPD Police Community Precincts.
