20 QC AREAS LOCKED DOWN

TWENTY areas in five villages in Quezon City were placed under a 14- day special concern lock-down beginning Wednesday, May 13, because of the high number of coronavirus cases.

Assistant City Administrator for Operations Alberto Kimpo said these areas were selected by the City Health Department based on the results of local testing through its Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit.

The areas are Sitio Militar in Barangay Bahay Toro; Vargas Compound- Adelfa Metro Heights-Abanay and Ancop Canada in Barangay Culiat; Lower Gulod in Barangay Sauyo; 318 Dakila Street 2nd Alley Kayaan B. and Masbate Street in Barangay Bataasan Hills; and Victory Avenue, ROTC Hunters, BMA Avenue and Agno Street in Barangay Tatalon.

As of May 11, Barangay Bahay Toro had 21 cases; Barangay Culiat, 37; Barangay Sauyo, 19; Barangay Batasan Hills, 29; and Barangay Tatalon, 17.

Kimpo assured residents of affected areas that the city government would provide food and other assistance.
