

QC COVID-19 cases hits 2,000

The number of novel coronavirus disease-2019 (COVID19) cases in Quezon City has risen to 2,000 which is 14.52 percent of the country's total tally of 13,777 based on the Department of Health (DoH) data as of 7 p.m. of May 23.

In the report of the **Quezon City Health Department (QCHD)**, the COVID-19 death toll now stands at 169, 19.59 percent of the latest DoH record of 863 deaths nationwide.

The QCHD listed 624 COVID-19 recoveries in Quezon City, which 19.64 percent of the total 3,177 recorded by the DoH for the nation during the same period.

Similar to past instances, the number of validated cases by the Quezon City Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit (QCESU) and District Health Offices is 1634,366, far off the DoH count of 2,000 during the same time frame.

The QCHD noted that the number of confirmed cases with complete addresses in Quezon City is 1,822 up by 33 from the previous 1,789.

In the same QCHD data, the active COVID-19 cases in Quezon City referring to those still alive is up by 56 from 785 to 841.
