ORDINANCE NO. SP- **2921** S- 2020

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 2, GENERAL FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020, IN THE AMOUNT OF FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE MILLION ONE HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE PESOS (PHP479,120,265.00), REPRESENTING THE 13<sup>TH</sup> MONTH IRA DOWNLOADED BY THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT PURSUANT TO REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11469 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "BAYANIHAN TO HEAL AS ONE ACT" TO FUND VARIOUS MAINTENANCE AND OTHER OPERATING EXPENSES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on 13 April 2020, Ordinance No. SP-2909, Series of 2020 was approved providing for a Supplemental Budget No. 1 in the amount of Two Billion Eight Hundred Million Pesos (Php2,800,000,000.00), in response to COVID-19 pandemic and for other operational expenses;

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WHEREAS, Section 4 of Republic Act No. 11469 (Bayanihan to Heal as One Act) granted the President the power to adopt various temporary emergency measures to respond to crisis brought by COVID-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, on 07 April 2020, the Department of Budget and Management has issued Local Budget Circular No. 125, prescribing guidelines and procedures on the release and utilization of the Bayanihan Grant to Cities and Municipalities (BGCM), which is equivalent to the one-month FY 2020 Internal Revenue Allotment share of the cities and municipalities;

WHEREAS, on 07 April 2020, the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) has release in favor of the City Government an amount of Four Hundred Seventy-Nine Million One Hundred Twenty Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-Five Pesos (Php479,120,265.00), in relation to Republic Act No. 11469 and Local Budget Circular No. 125 to aid the City in its response to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 and its impact to the community;

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the Finance Committee, duly certified by the City Treasurer, the said funds are actually available and there is a need to appropriate the aforementioned BGCM, in the amount of Four Hundred Seventy-Nine Million One Hundred Twenty Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-Five Pesos (Php479,120,265.00), to fund various Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses of the City Government to further respond to COVID-19 pandemic.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION – The amount of Four Hundred Seventy-Nine Million One Hundred Twenty Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-Five Pesos (Php479,120,265.00) is hereby declared as Supplemental Budget No. 2 to be defrayed for the following expenditures:

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**PART I – STATEMENT OF FUND**

*General Fund*

*Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses* PhP479,120,265.00

**PART II – STATEMENT OF SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS**

*Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses*

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**TOTAL SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION** PhP479,120,265.00

**SECTION 2.** *The City Mayor is hereby authorized to disburse the funds appropriated under Section 1 hereof, consistent with the Project Procurement Management Plan (PPMP) for the purpose consistent with the provisions of Republic Act No. 9184, its Implementing Rules and Regulations, and other existing and pertinent laws, rules, memorandum and order.*

*Provided further, that utilization of the funds appropriated herein shall be exclusively used for the Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPAs) and expenses enumerated under Section 3, paragraph 3.5 of Local Budger Circular No. 125 dated 07 April 2020.*

**SECTION 3. CREATION OF SPECIAL ACCOUNT** – *For monitoring/tracking of the utilization of the appropriated funds herein, a Special Account in the General Fund (SAGF) is hereby created pursuant to Section 313 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, as amended.*

**SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE** - *If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional or invalid, all other provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.*

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
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
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*SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.*
