

Confirmed QC contaminations reach over 2,000

The local government of Quezon City on Saturday announced that the total number of confirmed coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) cases in the city has reached 2,127 as of Friday night.

In a statement, the QC government said that of the total number of infected, 1,963 have complete addresses in Quezon City and the city's Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit and District Health Offices has validated 1,806 of the total cases.

The active COVID-19 cases as of Friday night were at 788, while 36 new recoveries were reported, bringing the total number of recoveries to 841 and the death toll increased to 177 after two new deaths were reported.

Some areas in the area remain under 14-day special concern lockdown which started on 13 May due to the number and clustering of COVID-19 cases and the areas still under special concern lockdown include Sitio Militar in Barangay Bahay Toro, Vargas Compound-Adelfa Metro Heights-Abanay and Ancop Canada in Barangay Culiat, Lower Gulod in Barangay Sauyo, 318 Dakila Street and 2nd Alley Kalayaan B and Masbate Street in Barangay Batasan Hills.

Also part of the special concern lockdown are Victory Avenue, ROTC Hunters, BMA Avenue and Agno Street in Barangay Tatalon, Certeza Compound, Barangay Culiat, Alley 2, Homart Road, Barangay Baesa and Victory Avenue, ROTC Hunters, BMA Avenue and Agno Street in Barangay Tatalon.

The QC city government reminded residents to stay home, wear face masks and observe social distancing to prevent the further spread of COVID-19.
