Two QC U-turn slots reopened

In response to the request of the Quezon City local government, the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) on early Friday morning reopened two U-turn slots it had closed a few months ago.

Assistant Secretary Celine Pialago, MMDA spokesperson, said the agency opted to open the U-turn slots near Quezon City Academy and Dario Bridge.

"The two U-turn slots were reopened at 6 a.m., near Quezon City Academy for light vehicles and Dario Bridge for emergency vehices," Pialago said.

The decision to reopen the U-turn slots was to ease traffic.

Earlier, Quezon City asked the MMDA to reopen the said slots due to numerous complaints it had been receiving from motorists.

The reopening of the said slots was revealed by the MMDA during a House committee hearing last Tuesday.

The U-turn slots in front of Quezon City Academy and near Dario bridge were closed in October and November, respectively.

The Quezon City local government lauded the MMDA's decision to reopen the U-turn slots.
