

QC bares new health measures for businesses

The **Quezon City government** on Monday released sweeping new health measures for businesses after its epidemiological office reported that 14 percent of the city's confirmed COVID-19 cases occurred in workplaces with many employees. The new rules, approved on March 14, cover entrances and exits, furniture and working stations and lunch breaks of employees. Of the 722 positive cases from Feb. 28 to March 13, 104 had occurred in workplaces with many employees. The infections then spread to households when the infected employees went home from work.
