

QC imposes liquor ban

Quezon City has instituted a liquor ban as part of the supplemental guidelines imposing emergency measures and protocols to curb the transmission of the virus in households, workplaces, and other establishments. The guidelines, which will be in effect from 15 to 31 March, covers workplaces, public areas and business establishments.

Apart from the reiteration of public safety hours, strict compliance to health protocols in workplaces, and mandatory use of the Kyusi Pass digital contact tracing app, the guideline includes the reimplementation of a two-week liquor ban.

All retail sales of alcoholic beverages are suspended for the duration of the guidelines.

Likewise, all gyms, spas and Internet cafes will also be closed for two weeks following an outbreak at a gym.
