QC issues more quarantine rules

The Office of the Quezon City Mayor has issued a second supplemental general community quarantine guidelines that require building managers and homeowners' associations to report positive Covid-19 cases among employees, tenants, residents, members or clients, regardless of their place of residence, to the City Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit within 24 hours from receipt of test results.

This measure was devised to contain further Covid-19 outbreaks in residential and commercial establishments, including condominiums and subdivisions.

Building managers have been tasked to maintain a log of all building guests and visitors, including addresses and contact information, using the KyusiPass as far as feasible.

Building managers must also disclose to their tenants and association members if there are any Covid-19 cases in the building, without mentioning the identities or unit location of the cases. They are also responsible for the monitoring and enforcement of health protocols, as well as tasked to supply necessities to quarantined persons within their respective buildings. @tribunephl_phau
