QC vaccination drive goes into high gear

The Quezon City (QC) government has added more vaccination sites through the help of the private sector.

Currently, the city boasts a total of 35 sites scattered in its six districts, exceeding the original 24 venues identified by the city when it laid out its vaccination plan to the national government.

QC is now vaccinating an average of 7,095 individuals a day. It has administered more than 229,500 doses of vaccines provided by the national government.

Among the vaccination sites include universities such as the Ateneo de Manila University and University of the Philippines Diliman; churches like Our Lady of Consolacion Parish, Sacred Heart Parish and Christ the King of the Universe Parish; malls such as SM City Malls and Robinsons Malls; the Araneta Coliseum, UP Technohub and Elements at Centris; and hotels such as Richmonde Hotel in Eastwood.

Aside from these, inoculations are done in schools, hospitals, clubhouses of homeowners' associations, barangay halls and covered courts.
