

Hero launches 'Health Caravan para sa Bayan'

BEING able to have a regular checkup is one of the keys to having good health. However, not everyone is fortunate enough to be able to visit a doctor regularly. Quezon City Fourth District Councilor Hero Bautista hoped to address this when he launched the Health Caravan Para Sa Bayan program in 2018.



The caravan is held every September, and it offers medical and dental checkups, free eye-glasses and medicines, free blood pressure checking, mass feeding, and blood donation, which would be given to LGU blood banks.

Over 7,000 people from 38 barangay have been served by the medical outreach program. Unfortunately, this year's caravan will be moved to a later date due to the pandemic, with Councilor Bautista hoping that it can be done by December this year.
