This came after the city government announced on Wednesday that it is now allowing minors to visit the park.

The QC governments, however, emphasized that only minors accompanied by their parents or guardians will be allowed to enter the vast park and indulge in fitness activities like walking or biking.

On Tuesday, the Metro Manila Council (MMC) approved travel and outdoor activities for the said age group.

Following the guidelines under the relaxed Alert level 3, the park can only accommodate 30 percent of its maximum capacity.
