Incentive for jabbed vendors in QC

The Quezon City government is providing incentives to ambulant vendors, market stall owners and their employees in exchange for getting Covid-19 vaccine shots.

Following the resolution of the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority to restrict the mobility of unvaccinated persons to protect them from severe or critical Covid, the Quezon City Council enacted an ordinance regulating the mobility of unvaccinated individuals in the city.

Meanwhile, the city government acknowledged that among the unvaccinated market vendors, market employees, and ambulant vendors who were earning their livelihoods on a day-to-day basis.

The City government opted to provide vendors and market employees with P2,000 each to offset any disruption in their income generating capacity.
