QC adopts no-contact apprehension system

The no-contact apprehension program against traffic violators will be implemented by the local government of Quezon City starting Friday, 1 July 2022.

Under the program, road video cameras are used to record traffic violations with traffic citation tickets sent to the homes of the registered owners of vehicles caught on camera.
