A RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING SENATOR RAFAEL TESHIBA TULFO, A.K.A RAFFY TULFO, AND ALL THE WINNING CANDIDATES IN THE SENATORIAL RACE OF MAY 2022 NATIONAL ELECTIONS.

WHEREAS, Senator Rafael Teshiba Tulfo placed third in the 2022 senatorial race and became a member of the 19th Congress of the Philippines after garnering a total of 23,396,954 votes;

WHEREAS, Senator Rafael Teshiba Tulfo is a Filipino politician, broadcast journalist, and a media personality who is currently based in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, Senator Rafael Teshiba Tulfo is known among his followers as "Mr. Action Man" and "Idol Raffy". He is the main host and commentator of Wanted sa Radyo and Idol in Action - two shows in which the main objectives are to resolve grievances and/or conflicts between disputing individuals and/or parties;

WHEREAS, Idol Raffy's most successful public service shows, Wanted sa Radyo and Idol in Action, are centered on directly engaging with listeners and viewers, providing an informal venue for lodging complaints and nudging "follow-up" actions on previous reports, connecting "help-seeking" callers both with government agencies and private entities and mediating relationship squabbles;

WHEREAS, Idol Raffy is a known champion of the poor, the abused and the marginalized. He fights for the downtrodden – many of whom are laborers – who flock to his radio show every day to seek for his help;

WHEREAS, Idol Raffy previously stated that he sought a Senate seat to fix the "broken system in government" that he claimed made his shows necessary for ordinary Filipinos. Drawing from the problems raised in his show's action centers, he cited three areas he will prioritize – Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs), labor and family;

WHEREAS, the good senator is currently handed-over the chairmanship of the Committees on Cooperatives; Cultural Communities; Economic Affairs; Education, Arts and Culture; Electoral Reforms and People's Participation; and Energy;

WHEREAS, actor Robin Padilla, who is in 1^{st} place with 26,612,434 votes together with broadcaster Raffy Tulfo, who is in 3^{rd} place with 23,396,954 votes and former Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) Secretary Mark Villar, who is in 6^{th} place with 19,475,592 votes are all first-time law-makers;

WHEREAS, the five former senators that also took their oaths were former Antique Representative Loren Legarda, who is in 2nd place with 24,264,979 votes; former Sorsogon Governor Chiz Escudero, who is in 5th place with 20,271,458 votes; former House Speaker Alan Peter Cayetano, who is in 7th place with 19,295,314 votes; JV Ejercito who is in 10th place with 15,841,858 votes; and Jinggoy Estrada, who is in 12th place with 15,108,220 votes;

WHEREAS, re-electionist senatorial candidates who were able to enter the "Magic 12" were Senator Sherwin Gatchalian, who is in 4th place with 20,535,261 votes; Senator Miguel Zubiri, who is in 8th place with 18,734,336 votes; Senator Joel Villanueva, who is in 9th place with 18,486,034 votes; and Senator Risa Hontiveros, who is in 11th place with 15,420,807 votes;

WHEREAS, the senators elected in the May 2022 elections, together with those elected in 2019 will comprise the Senate's delegation in the 19th Congress;
