WHEREAS, in 2021, the 21st Quezon City Council enacted Ordinance No. SP-3063, S-2021, entitled "An Ordinance Approving The Annual Budget Of The Quezon City Government For Calendar Year 2022 In The Amount Of Thirty Billion Five Hundred Million Pesos (Php30,500,000,000.00) Covering The Various Expenditures For The Operation Of The City Government And Appropriating The Necessary Funds For The Purpose";

WHEREAS, Section 50 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates the adoption of the Internal Rules of Procedure of the Sanggunian during its first regular session following the election of its members;

WHEREAS, the 22nd Quezon City Council approved and adopted last August 08, 2022, PR22CC-038 entitled "A Resolution Amending The Internal Rules Of Procedure Of The 22nd Quezon City Council";

WHEREAS, Section 14, Rule IV of the 22nd City Council Internal Rules of Procedure enumerates the Regular Committees of the Quezon City Council;

WHEREAS, in the 22nd City Council Internal Rules of Procedure, there are new committees that were either created, merged or separated from those that were approved in the previous City Council Internal Rules of Procedure, which were also the subjects of appropriation of Ordinance No. SP-3063, S-2021;
