RESOLUTION NO. SP-9051, S-2022

A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION TO CONDUCT A ONE-DAY ON-SITE APPLICATION OF BARANGAY OFFICIAL ELIGIBILITY AT QUEZON CITY HALL.

WHEREAS, the Barangay Official Eligibility (BOE) is granted by the CSC pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", to elective and appointive barangay officials based on completion of their term of office;

WHEREAS, Section 393 of the same Code provides for the benefits accorded to barangay officials, to wit:

"Section 393. Benefits of Barangay Officials. -

(b) The Punong Barangay, the Sangguniang Barangay Members, the Barangay Treasurer, and the Barangay Secretary shall also:

- (5) Be entitled to appropriate civil service eligibility on the basis of the number of years of service to the barangay, pursuant to the rules and regulations issued by the Civil Service Commission.
- (c) Elective barangay officials shall have preference in appointments to any government position or in any government-owned or controlled corporations, including their subsidiaries, after their tenure of office, subject to the requisite qualifications and the provisions of the immediately preceding paragraph."

WHEREAS, Section 4 of Republic Act No. 11768, otherwise known as the Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015, provides for the benefits accorded to Sangguniang Kabataan officials, to wit:

"Section 4. Privileges of Sangguniang Kabataan Officials. - (a) All Sangguniang Kabataan officials in good standing, whether elected or appointed, shall during their incumbency:

- (7) Be entitled to the appropriate civil service eligibility based on the years of service to the barangay pursuant to the rules and regulations to be promulgated by the Civil Service Commission (CSC)
 - (b) The Sangguniang Kabataan chairperson shall have the same privileges enjoyed by other Sangguniang Kabataan officials under this Act subject to such requirements and limitations provided herein."

WHEREAS, one of the basic requirement for employment/hiring in government service is the Civil Service Eligibility;

WHEREAS, numerous barangay officials who finished or completed their term are not knowledgeable of this provision nor have the ample time to avail thereof due to distance;

WHEREAS, the conduct of a one-day on-site application of Barangay Official Eligibility at the Quezon City Hall is beneficial to former barangay officials employed by the Quezon City government, as well as other national government agencies;

WHEREAS, this on-site application will benefit the former barangay officials and ease them from their burden for transportation and other documentary requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to earnestly request, as it does hereby earnestly request, the Civil Service Commission to conduct a one-day on-site application of Barangay Official Eligibility at Quezon City Hall.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to furnish the Civil Service Commission a copy of this Resolution for their information.
