

QC taps 1,000 personnel for Undas'

More than 1,000 personnel of the Quezon City government were deployed to seven cemeteries last Saturday for a safe and orderly commemoration of “Undas.”

The personnel from the Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS), Task Force for Transport and Traffic Management (TFTTM), Task Force Disiplina, Quezon City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (DRRMO), Quezon City Barangay and Community Relations Department (BCRD), and Quezon City Police District (Qcpd) were assigned to him layang Pilipino Memorial Park, Bagbag Cemetery, Holy Cross Memorial Park, Recuerdo Memorial Gardens, Novaliches Cemetery, Manila North Cemetery, and San Juan Cemetery until Nov. 2 to ensure peace and order and provide help like medical assistance to visitors. The city government said that guidelines for Undas will be posted on its Facebook page. Meanwhile, the Malabon city government posted on Facebook the schedule of the six private cemeteries from Oct. 29 to Nov. 2 as well as its emergency hotline numbers.
