AN ORDINANCE CONSERVING THE GABALDON HALL IN PLACIDO DEL MUNDO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL LOCATED AT QUIRINO HIGHWAY, BARANGAY TALIPAPA, DISTRICT VI, QUEZON CITY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

*WHEREAS, the Placido Del Mundo Elementary School in Barangay Talipapa, District VI, Quezon City is currently maintaining and operating a Gabaldon Hall within the school premises;*

*WHEREAS, under Republic Act No. 11194, otherwise known as the "Gabaldon School Buildings Conservation Act", in relation to Republic Act No. 10066, Gabaldon School Buildings shall be conserved, the same being recognized as built heritage and included as part of cultural property;*

WHEREAS, Section 14, Article IV of the 1987 Constitution provides that:

*“The State shall foster the preservation, enrichment, and dynamic evolution of a Filipino national culture based on the principle of unity in diversity in a climate of free artistic and intellectual expression.”*

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:


SECTION 1. CONSERVATION OF GABALDON HALL. – *The Office of the City Mayor and the Schools Division Office of Quezon City, in consultation with the Department of Education (DepEd), National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), and the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP), shall implement a program for the conservation of Gabaldon Hall in Placido Del Mundo Elementary School located at Quirino Highway, Barangay Talipapa, District VI, Quezon City.*

SECTION 2. CHANGES IN GABALDON HALL. – *Any modification, destruction, alteration, demolition, or relocation of the said Gabaldon Hall shall be subject to the provisions of Section 5 of Republic Act No. 11194.*

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. – *The amount necessary for the maintenance and operation of the said Gabaldon Hall shall be continually appropriated in the city’s Annual Budget as share or counterpart of the city government to the funding allocation of the DepEd.*

SECTION 4. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS. – *Within sixty (60) days from the approval of this Ordinance, the Office of the City Administrator and the Head of the Schools Division of Quezon City shall formulate the necessary rules and regulations for the effective implementation of this Ordinance.*


