WHEREAS, Mr. Jose Efren Bagamasbad, despite being sixty-six (66) years old, finished first place and bagged the gold medal and got the title as the newest International Master of the Philippines during the Asian Seniors Chess Championship 2022 (Over 65 Category) held in Auckland, New Zealand on October 15-21, 2022;

WHEREAS, he has participated and won in several competitions, namely, 1976 Alternate Player of UST Engineering team; 1977 to 1979 Board 1 player of UST Engineering team; 1978 Board 3 player of UST representing Manila in the National UAAP Champion in Cebu City; the 1979 Board 1 player of UST representing Manila in the National UAAP, First Runner-Up in Baguio City; 1977 to 1979 Alternate player of DILG, 1981 National Executive Chess Champion; 1987 Caloocan City Non Master Chess Champion; 1989 National Executive Chess Champion, June 1990 10th place in the Far East Bank International Chess Open got the title of National Master; March 2012, Rapid Chess Champion Putra Jaya, Malaysia; October 2017 Triple tie for Second in the Asian Seniors Chess Championship 50 to 64 years old category got the title of Fide Master; and on October 15 to 21, 2022 Asian Seniors Chess Champion above 65 years old category in Auckland, New Zealand got the title of International Master plus one Grandmaster Norm, among others;

WHEREAS, Mr. Bagamasbad currently resides at Barangay Sto. Niño, Quezon City since 1983;

WHEREAS, Mr. Bagamasbad has also earned a Degree in Bachelor of Science in Chemical Engineering at the University of Sto. Tomas from 1973 to 1979;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government recognizes and commends the relentless hardwork and determination of Filipino athletes who brought honor to the City and country as well.


