A RESOLUTION URGING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, THROUGH THE GREEN TRANSPORT OFFICE, TO IDENTIFY AND DESIGNATE GREEN ROUTES FOR ELECTRIC TRICYCLES.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11697, otherwise known as the Electric Vehicle Industry Development Act (EVIDA Law), lapsed into law without being approved or vetoed by the President on April 15, 2022;

WHEREAS, under the EVIDA Law, the local government units are mandated to identify and designate green routes to be exclusively traversed by Electric Utility Vehicle (E-Trikes);

WHEREAS, among the incentives given by EVIDA Law is the prioritization of registration, renewal of registration, and issuance of special type of vehicle plate issued by the LTO;

WHEREAS, the Land Transportation Franchising Regulatory Board (LTFRB) is given directive to expeditiously process applications for franchise to operate, including its renewal; in principle, its local counterpart, the Tricycle Franchising Board (TFB) is included to this mandate;

WHEREAS, the Department of Energy (DOE) donated 300 E-Trikes to the local government of Quezon City and was accepted by the latter through Resolution No. SP-7725, Series of 2019;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government through the effort of City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, launched the first pilot "E-Trike" Project in Barangay Sacred Heart with much success;

WHEREAS, E-Trikes will eventually turn Quezon City into a green city by encouraging tricycle organizations to use these environment-friendly E-Trikes.

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Quezon City Government, through the Green Transport Office, to identify and designate green routes for Electric Tricycles.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution be furnished to the Green Transport Office, for appropriate action.
