RESOLUTION NO. SP- **9201**, S-2023

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN AN AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH - METRO MANILA CENTER FOR HEALTH DEVELOPMENT (DOH-MMCHD), REPRESENTED BY DIRECTOR IV ALELI ANNIE GRACE P. SUDIACAL, MD, MPH, CESE, BY SIGNING THE TERMS OF PARTNERSHIP FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE APPROVED ANNUAL OPERATIONS PLAN CY 2023.

WHEREAS, Section 11, Article XIII of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides, among others, that the State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development, which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health, and social services available to all people at affordable cost;

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WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandated the devolution of the delivery of health services and facilities as one of the basic functions and responsibilities of all Local Government Units (LGUs) at all levels;

WHEREAS, Section 22 of Republic Act No. 11223, otherwise known as the Universal Health Care (UHC) Act of 2019, mandated the National Government to make available the commensurate financial and non-financial matching grants, including capital outlay, human resources for health and health commodities, to improve the functionality of province-wide and city-wide health systems, provided that the grants shall be in accordance with the approved province-wide and city-wide health investment plans;

WHEREAS, Quezon City has agreed to implement health sector reforms consistent with the UHC Act and the FOURmula One Plus for Health and has proven its capacity to utilize investment and sustain the reform process, among others;

WHEREAS, the Local Investment Plan for Health (LIPH) is the key instrument in forging the Department of Health (DOH) and Local Government Unit (LGU) partnership to carry out the FOURmula One Plus for Health, and technical assistance from the DOH shall be consolidated and matched with the needs outlined in the LIPH; and whereas the implementation of the LIPH is translated through the Annual Operation Plans (AOP);

WHEREAS, Quezon City has agreed to fund and implement the programs, projects, and activities under LIPHS/AOPs through own financing source, and through available funds and resources from the DOH, and development partners, coordinated with the DOH;

WHEREAS, Quezon City has prepared its 2023-2025 LIPH and 2023 AOP, which have been reviewed by the City and Department of Health - Metro Manila Center for Health Development (DOH-MMCHD) Appraisal Committee, and modified as necessary, following the recommendations of the above;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

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
NOW, THEREFORE,
