A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE SPECIAL PERMIT OF KING SOLOMON SPORTS CENTER CORPORATION (STA. MONICA COCKPIT), LOCATED AT NO. 26 SARMIENTO STREET, BARANGAY STA. MONICA, QUEZON CITY, FOR THE OPERATION OF ITS BUSINESS FOR THE PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS RECKONED FROM THE DATE OF APPROVAL OF THIS RESOLUTION, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE EXISTING LAWS, RULES, AND REGULATIONS, AND SUBJECT TO THE PAYMENT OF CORRESPONDING TAXES, FEES, AND OTHER CHARGES THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, King Solomon Sports Center Corporation (Sta. Monica Cockpit) is a duly organized corporation existing under Philippine Laws with an office address at No. 26 Sarmiento Street, Barangay Sta. Monica, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, King Solomon Sports Center Corporation (Sta. Monica Cockpit) is the only duly licensed cockpit in Quezon City, which has been in operation for seventeen (17) years, and has gained an impressive reputation in the cockfighting industry;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. SP-1223, S-2022 grants the King Solomon Sports Center Corporation (Sta. Monica Cockpit) a twenty-five (25)-year franchise to establish, construct, operate, and maintain a sports center and arena. Likewise, the applicant was previously granted a Fix-Term Special Permit by the Quezon City Council for the operation of the same business through Resolution No. SP-7987, S-2019;

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to continue its business operations, there is a need to renew the Special Permit granted by the City Council;

WHEREAS, the grant of a Special Permit to King Solomon Sports Center Corporation (Sta. Monica Cockpit) will mean continued remittance of taxes, fees, and other charges to the City Government.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to renew, as it does hereby renew, the Special Permit of King Solomon Sports Center Corporation (Sta. Monica Cockpit), located at No. 26 Sarmiento Street, Barangay Sta. Monica, Quezon City, for the operation of its business for the period of two (2) years reckoned from the date of approval of this Resolution, in accordance with the existing laws, rules, and regulations, and subject to the payment of corresponding taxes, fees, and other charges therefor.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Fix-Term Special Permit granted herein shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. The holding of a cockfight shall be in accordance with the Rules and Regulations promulgated by Games and Amusement Board (GAB);
2. The operation is enjoined to prohibit individuals below eighteen (18) years of age or students of any school, college, or university from playing in the abovementioned games in their gaming site;
3. This Resolution is non-assignable, non-transferrable, and site-address specific;
4. The establishment shall not be a nuisance to public safety and order;
5. The establishment shall comply with all clearance, documentary requirements, and other applicable local and national laws; and

6. The establishment shall strictly enforce the use of available modern technology, including, but not limited to, digital or automated closed-circuit betting system, which is accessible solely within the cockpit, to prevent the possible transmission of infectious diseases.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that the Special Permit granted to King Solomon Sports Center Corporation (Sta. Monica Cockpit) shall be subject to the conditions set forth by the Gambling Regulatory Advisory Council (GRAC) Resolution, and a Letter of No Objection is issued by the Business Permits and Licensing Department of Quezon City.
