WHEREAS, carrying the theme "Smart Logistic Robotics," the competition was focused on creativity of robotics in logistics where the participants were tasked to craft robots in all logistics, supply chain, and delivery areas;

WHEREAS, the WRG aims to improve the learners' ability to face and solve gamified challenges that stimulate real-life unknown situations and difficulties; motivate students, parents and teachers to work together to develop students' talent for STEM college choices or careers; and encourage students to take ownership of their own learning paths and achieve their own academic objectives;

WHEREAS, the competition also aimed to cultivate the tradition of friendly competition and camaraderie among participants in robotic games while enabling learners to learn and have firsthand experience working with technology while having fun;

WHEREAS, the Philippine robotics team, composed of students and coaches from eleven (11) schools in the country, competed in several game categories and won 91 Medals and 55 Medals of Diligence Awards;
