A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE OF EXCEPTION TO HAP CHAN TRADING AND MANAGEMENT CORP., REPRESENTED BY JOHN G. SY AND OWNER OF LOTS WITH TRANSFER CERTIFICATE OF TITLE NOS. 004-2016007272 AND 004-2018003169, FOR THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF EIGHT (8)-STOREY COMMERCIAL BUILDING LOCATED AT LOTS 6 AND 7, BLOCK D-5, NO. 687 AURORA BOULEVARD, BARANGAY DUYAN-DUYAN, DISTRICT III, QUEZON CITY, ALLOWING DEVIATION FROM THE RESTRICTIONS PROVIDED UNDER ORDINANCE NO. SP-2502, S-2016, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE OF 2016

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WHEREAS, Hap Chan Trading and Management Corp., represented by John G. Sy, is applying for a Certificate of Exception for the proposed construction of Eight (8)-Storey Commercial Building located at Lots 6 and 7, Block D-5, No. 687 Aurora Boulevard, Barangay Duyan-Duyan, District III, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Paragraph 2, Section 55, Article VIII of Ordinance No. SP-2502, S-2016, an exception is required for the aforesaid construction project upon authorization from the City Council;

WHEREAS, the proposed project will not adversely affect public health, safety and welfare, and is in keeping with the general pattern of development in the community;

WHEREAS, the proposed project shall support economic-based activities and provide livelihood, vital community services and facilities, and at the same time, poses no adverse effect on the zone or community;

WHEREAS, the exception of the proposed project will not adversely affect the appropriate use of the adjoining property in the same district;

WHEREAS, the exception of the proposed project will not alter the essential character and general purpose of the district where the exception sought is located;

WHEREAS, the applicant has complied with the mandatory requirements prescribed by law, ordinance or administrative issuances;

WHEREAS, the applicant has submitted the necessary and mandatory requirements in support of the proposed project, and undertakes to comply with the provisions of existing laws, ordinances, and rules and regulations pertaining to environmental protection and vehicular traffic.



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NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the issuance of a Certificate of Exception to Hap Chan Trading and Management Corp., represented by John G. Sy and owner of lots with Transfer Certificate of Title Nos. 004-2016007272 and 004-2018003169, for the proposed construction of Eight (8)-Storey Commercial Building located at Lots 6 and 7, Block D-5, No. 687 Aurora Boulevard, Barangay Duyan-Duyan, District III, Quezon City, allowing deviation from the restrictions provided under Ordinance No. SP-2502, S-2016, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 2016.
