A RESOLUTION DONATING THE ONE HUNDRED (100) UNITS OF FOOD CARTS TO DIFFERENT BENEFICIARIES FROM THIRTY-SEVEN (37) BARANGAYS OF THE 1ST DISTRICT OF QUEZON CITY, AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF THE SAME TO THE RECIPIENTS WITHOUT COST

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government values the importance of small business sector in this City; and to support the daily life of the recipients and integrate them to be responsible in handling business, one hundred (100) units of food carts were purchased through the allocated funds of the City Government;

WHEREAS, since these food carts will be utilized by the recipients for their daily livelihood activity in their respective Barangays, it is just and proper to turn over the ownership and maintenance of the said food carts to the recipients;

WHEREAS, to effectively turn over the ownership of the said food carts to the recipients without incurring any cost, a Deed of Donation shall be executed in favor of said recipients, with all the fees and costs to be assumed by the City.
