BELMONTE, ON BEHALF OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, TO DONATE SEVENTY-ONE (71) UNITS OF AMBULANT FOOD CARTS TO THE THIRTY-SEVEN (37) BARANGAYS IN DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY AND TO TRANSFER THE OWNERSHIP OF SAID AMBULANT FOOD CARTS TO ALL THE RECIPIENTS WITHOUT COST

Belmonte, on behalf of the Quezon City Government, to donate seventy-one (71) units of Ambulant Food Carts to the thirty-seven (37) barangays in District I, Quezon City and to transfer the ownership of said Ambulant Food Carts to all the recipients without cost.
