A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO PILIPINAS SHELL PETROLEUM CORPORATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A GASOLINE REFILLING STATION (AS BUILT) LOCATED AT LOT 5, BLOCK 31, COMMONWEALTH AVENUE, BARANGAY FAIRVIEW, DISTRICT V, QUEZON CITY

WHEREAS, Pilipinas Shell Petroleum Corporation, a business entity duly registered under Philippine laws, is applying for the issuance of a Special Use Permit to be used for the construction and operation of a Gasoline Refilling Station (As Built) located at Lot 5, Block 31, Commonwealth Avenue, Barangay Fairview, District V, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. SP-2502, S-2016, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 2016, a Special Use Permit shall be required for the construction and operation of a gasoline refilling station, subject to the authorization by the City Council through a Resolution;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the issuance of a Special Use Permit to Pilipinas Shell Petroleum Corporation for the construction and operation of a Gasoline Refilling Station (As Built) located at Lot 5, Block 31, Commonwealth Avenue, Barangay Fairview, District V, Quezon City.
