WHEREAS, the 2023 Southeast Asian Games, also known as the 32<sup>nd</sup> SEA Games and a biennial sports multi-sport event which was held from May 5-17, 2023 in Phnom Penh, Cambodia, had eleven (11) participating nations;

WHEREAS, the official motto for the 32<sup>nd</sup> SEA Games is "Sports Live in Peace";

*WHEREAS, the 32<sup>nd</sup> SEA Games, which initially planned to feature 40 sports, finally featured 37 sports, including fencing;*

*WHEREAS, the fencing competition took place on May 11-16, 2023 at Chroy Changvar Convention Centre in Phnom Penh, Cambodia. The fencing competition featured six (6) events: three (3)-individual and three (3)-team events;*

*WHEREAS, fencing, which is a combat sport with “swords”, features three (3) disciplines, namely foil, épée, and sabre;*

*WHEREAS, Samantha Kyle Catantan garnered silver in the Women’s Individual Foil event;*

*WHEREAS, Andrea Jennelle Matias bagged silver in the Women’s Individual Épée event;*

*WHEREAS, Jylyn Nicanor won bronze in the Women’s Individual Sabre event;*

*WHEREAS, Queen Denise Dalmacio, Jylyn Nicanor and Nicole Cortey won silver in the Women’s Sabre Team event;*

*WHEREAS, Maricar Matienzo, Justine Gail Tinio, Samantha Kyle Catantan and Janna Allysah Catantan bagged bronze in the Women’s Team Foil event;*

*WHEREAS, Nathaniel Perez, Prince John Francis Felipe and Shawn Nicollei Felipe won bronze in the Men’s Team Foil event;*

*WHEREAS, all in all, the Philippine Fencing Team obtained three (3) silver medals and three (3) bronze medals in the 2023 Southeast Asian Games;*

*WHEREAS, there are a total of twenty-four (24) delegates from the Philippine Fencing Team, twelve (12) of which are from Quezon City. Among the said 12 QCitizens, 11 members are from the QC SEP Fencing, which started in 2005, with the aim to provide training to future fencers, and develop their sportsmanship, hone their talent and empower them from the grassroots, thereby leading to multiple education opportunities.*

*WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper for the City Government to recognize and commend the hard work and determination of the fencing athletes who represented the Philippines and who brought honor and pride to our country in the 2023 Southeast Asian Games.*


