RESOLUTION NO. SP- 9342, S-2023

A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE SPECIAL PERMIT OF NDM BINGO CENTER/HALL FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF ELECTRONIC BINGO (E-BINGO) GAMES AT THOMPSON'S SQUARE UNIT C4, NO. 165 TOMAS MORATO AVENUE CORNER DON ALEJANDRO ROCES AVENUE, BARANGAY OBRERO, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR)

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WHEREAS, NDM Bingo Center/Hall, a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of Philippine laws, represented by Mr. Perry Weinne Lato and with business address at Thompson's Square Unit C4, No. 165 Tomas Morato Avenue corner Don Alejandro Roces Avenue, Barangay Obrero, District IV, Quezon City, Metro Manila, is applying for a renewal of Special Permit to operate a Bingo Hall or Electronic Bingo Games establishment;

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WHEREAS, the applicant was previously granted a Special Permit by the Quezon City Council for the operation of the same business through Resolution No. SP-8332, S-2020;

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to continue its business operations, there is a need to renew its Special Permit pursuant to an existing City ordinance;

WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2773, S-2018, as amended, and Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, authorize the City Council to grant or renew a Special Permit to business activities of the same nature.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to renew, as it does hereby renew, the Special Permit of NDM Bingo Center/ Hall for the establishment and operation of Electronic Bingo (E-Bingo) Games at Thompson's Square Unit C4, No. 165 Tomas Morato Avenue corner Don Alejandro Roces Avenue, Barangay Obrero, District IV, Quezon City, subject to the rules and regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the authority to operate an Electronic Bingo Games establishment granted herein shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. The holding of E-Bingo Games shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated by PAGCOR;
2. The operation of an E-Bingo Games establishment shall not include playing of games not related to or other than E-Bingo Games;
3. NDM Bingo Center/Hall is enjoined to prohibit from playing the abovementioned games in its gaming site individuals below twenty-one (21) years of age or students of any school, college or university;
4. NDM Bingo Center/Hall shall remit to the City Treasurer a license fee of three percent (3%) of the gross receipt of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the City Treasurer during the lifetime of this Resolution in accordance with Section 25 of Ordinance No. SP-2773, S-2018, as amended; and






5. *This Resolution is non-assignable, non-transferrable and site-address specific.*

*RESOLVED FINALLY, that this renewal of a Special Permit to operate an E-Bingo Games establishment shall be valid for a period of two (2) years from the approval of this Resolution and may be renewed again by the City Council.*
