WHEREAS, Undersecretary Martin B. Diño was born on July 25, 1957 and grew up in Barangay San Antonio District I, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, Undersecretary Martin B. Diño served as an employee of the Quezon City Government as Barangay Affairs Worker from October 1983 to June 1989 and as Community Affairs Assistant I from July 1989 to March 1992;

WHEREAS, Undersecretary Martin B. Diño was later elected as Punong Barangay of Barangay San Antonio, District I, Quezon City for three (3) consecutive terms from June 1, 1994 to May 31, 1997, June 1, 1997 to August 15, 2002, and August 16, 2002 to November 30, 2007;

WHEREAS, Undersecretary Martin B. Diño also served as the Vice-Chairperson of the Volunteers Against Crime and Corruption (VACC);

WHEREAS, in 2016, Undersecretary Martin B. Diño was appointed by Former President Rodrigo Duterte as Chairperson of the Subic Bay Metropolitan Authority (SBMA) and in 2017, as Undersecretary of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) and was in-charge of local government and barangay affairs;

WHEREAS, Undersecretary Martin B. Diño fought against crime and corruption with passion and integrity and was instrumental in implementing various programs and projects that benefitted the country;

WHEREAS, the contribution of Undersecretary Martin B. Diño extends not only to his length of service to Quezon City as a barangay official but to the country as a dedicated public official.
