BELMONTE, TO SIGN AND ACCEPT THE DEED OF DONATION WITH THE NATIONAL GRID CORPORATION OF THE PHILIPPINES (NGCP) FOR THE DONATION OF COVID-19 TESTING BOOTHS, COVID-19 TOTAL ANTIBODY TESTING, AND ANTIGEN RAPID DIAGNOSTIC TESTING SERVICES FOR THE SIX (6) DISTRICTS OF QUEZON CITY, AMOUNTING TO FIVE MILLION ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED PESOS (PHP5,166,800.00)

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2020, President Rodrigo R. Duterte issued Proclamation No. 922, S-2020 declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the country in recognition of the COVID-19 pandemic as a threat to national security, prompting a whole-of-government approach in addressing the outbreak in the country;

WHEREAS, Presidential Proclamation No. 929, S-2020, signed on March 16, 2020, declared a State of Calamity throughout the country due to COVID-19 for a period of six (6) months and enjoined all government agencies and the local government units (LGUs) to render full assistance to, and cooperation with each other, and mobilize the necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent and appropriate disaster response aid and measures in a timely manner to curtail and eliminate the threat of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, the National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) has donated medical equipment, items and materials, amounting to Five Million One Hundred Sixty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (Php5,166,800.00) and consisting of COVID-19 testing booths, total antibody testing, and antigen rapid diagnostic testing services, which are all necessary to screen and respond to COVID-19 cases for the six (6) districts of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455(b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to sign and accept the Deed of Donation with the National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) for the donation of COVID-19 testing booths, COVID-19 total antibody testing, and antigen rapid diagnostic testing services for the six (6) districts of Quezon City amounting to Five Million One Hundred Sixty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (Php5,166,800.00).
