WHEREAS, the Golden Gate International Choral Festival, which was established in 1991, is one of the largest and most recognized international youth choral festivals in the United States of America (USA), attracting hundreds of contestants from around the world every three years, for a week filled with competitive showcase of choral skills;

WHEREAS, during the Festival held from July 9 to 15, 2023 in San Francisco, California, USA., the Young Voices of the Philippines, under the baton of Conductor Dr. Maria Theresa Vizconde-Roldan and Artistic Director Prof. Jude B. Roldan, placed as the 1st Prize Winner in all four (4) competitions of the Festival - Historical Competition, Folk Competition, Gospel/Spiritual Competition, and Contemporary Competition - for the Youth Choir category during their first USA tour;

WHEREAS, it is fitting for the Quezon City Government to recognize and commend the hard work and determination of these young choristers for bringing honor to their community, to their Country, and to this City;

WHEREAS, with this feat, Young Voices of the Philippines has shown its dedication to excellence in the field of music and youth development, as well as in promoting Filipino artistry to the world.
