A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL PERMIT TO LUCKY TAYA GAMING CORPORATION (SHARK'S BILLIARD LEAGUE, INC.) **FOR** THE**OPERATION** OF**ELECTRONIC** *GAMES* (E-GAMES) ESTABLISHMENT AT NO. 234 TOMAS MORATO STREET, BARANGAY SOUTH TRIANGLE, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR)

WHEREAS, Lucky Taya Gaming Corporation (Shark's Billiard League, Inc.), a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of Philippine laws, and with business address at No. 234 Tomas Morato Street, Barangay South Triangle, District IV, Quezon City, is applying for a Special Permit to operate an Electronic Games (E-Games) establishment;

WHEREAS, the Corporation is applying for a Special Permit for the operation of an E-Games establishment;

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to conduct electronic gaming activities in their business operations, there is a need to apply for a Special Permit for the operation of an E-Games establishment pursuant to an existing city ordinance;

WHEREAS, the operation of an E-Games establishment is regulated and licensed by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR);

WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2773, S-2018, as amended, and Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, authorize the City Council to grant or renew a special permit to business activities of the same nature.

## NOW, THEREFORE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, the issuance of a Special Permit to Lucky Taya Gaming Corporation (Shark's Billiard League, Inc.) for the operation of Electronic Games (E-Games) establishment at No. 234 Tomas Morato Street, Barangay South Triangle, District IV, Quezon City, subject to the rules and regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the authority to operate an E-Games establishment granted herein shall be subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The holding of E-Games shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated by PAGCOR.
- 2. The operation of an E-Games establishment shall not include playing of games not related to or other than E-Games.
- 3. The operation is enjoined to prohibit from playing in the abovementioned games in their gaming site individuals below twenty-one (21) years of age or students of any school, college or university.
- 4. Lucky Taya Gaming Corporation (Shark's Billiard League, Inc.) shall remit to the City Treasurer's Office a license fee of three percent (3%) of the gross receipt of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the City Treasurer's Office during the lifetime of this Resolution in accordance with Section 25 of Ordinance No. SP-2773, S-2018, as amended.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that this issuance of Special Permit to operate an E-Games establishment shall be valid for a period of two (2) years from the approval of this Resolution and may be renewed again by the City Council.
