*WHEREAS, the ASEAN Para Games, a multi-sport event for athletes with disabilities, is held every other year under the regulation of ASEAN Para Sports Federation with supervision by the International Paralympic Committee and Asian Paralympic Committee;*

*WHEREAS, the 2023 ASEAN Para Games is the 12<sup>th</sup> ASEAN Para Games held in Phnom Penh, Cambodia;*

*WHEREAS, the 2023 ASEAN Para Games has one thousand four hundred fifty-three (1,453) athlete participants which includes the Philippine Delegation composed of two hundred fifty-nine (259) people of which one hundred seventy-four (174) are athletes competing in 13 sports; said delegation is led by Chef de Mission Walter Torres;*

*WHEREAS, the Philippines finished fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) overall in the medal tally with thirty-four (34) gold, thirty-three (33) silver and fifty (50) bronze medals; among the athletes is Mr. Jayson Ocampo, who won bronze in Para Table Tennis - Men’s Class 8 Team;*
