QCPD records improved crime clearance, solution efficiency

The Quezon City Police District (QCPD) yesterday reported improvement in crime clearance and crime solution efficiency in 2023.

During flag-raising rites at Camp Karingal, QCPD director Redrico Maranan said crime clearance efficiency increased by 10.47 percent while crime solution efficiency went up by 5.44 percent, highlighting the district's effectiveness in filing charges against criminals and resolving crimes.
