Galarpe began his career in public service as a humble Clerk at the Office of the Mayor in 1951, from which he rose from the ranks until he retired as Chief of the Business Permits and Licensing Office, and was thereafter elected as 3-termer City Councilor for the 1<sup>st</sup> District of the 11<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> Quezon City Council from 1988 to 1998;*

WHEREAS, as Councilor for 3 consecutive terms, Alberto M. Galarpe has served in the City Council in various capacities such as Majority Floor Leader, Chairman of the Committee on Laws, Rules and Internal Government, Chairman of other Committees – Ways and Means, Public Affairs and Information and Vice Chairman of all existing Committees of the City Council;

WHEREAS, Councilor Alberto M. Galarpe is fondly known and remembered as “the Master of Taxation” of the City Council due to his wide and vast experience as the retired Chief of the then Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO), enabling him to craft measures towards the effective and efficient generation of revenues needed to support the various programs and activities of the Quezon City Government;

WHEREAS, Councilor Alberto M. Galarpe is the principal author of other relevant revenue-regulating measures and social legislations including the Liquor Ordinance and the Ordinance creating the Liquor Licensing and Regulatory Board which regulate the sale, serving and dispensing of all kinds of intoxicating liquors in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, Councilor Alberto M. Galarpe devoted almost 4 decades of his life for a dedicated and unblemished public service, receiving consistently the Manuel Luis Quezon Bantayog Award – a fitting testimonial to his outstanding performance as a legislator having authored in different capacities a total of 1,069 Ordinances and Resolutions;

WHEREAS, Councilor Alberto M. Galarpe is the epitome of an exceptional leader and public servant worthy of emulation and respect;

WHEREAS, the City Mayor, Vice Mayor and Members of the 22<sup>nd</sup> City Council were informed of the unfortunate news of the demise of the late Councilor Alberto “Bert” M. Galarpe on March 3, 2024 so they hereby express their unanimous sentiment to sympathize with the family and friends of the late Councilor of the 1<sup>st</sup> District.
