WHEREAS, QCU, in cooperation with LifeSkillsPH, aims to provide formal curricula-based trainings at the University to develop knowledge and skills relating to specific technical and vocational courses to be called LifeSkillsPH Program;

WHEREAS, the LifeSkillsPH Program will be a key program in providing our students with technical-vocational skills, and more opportunities for development.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the Quezon City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into and sign a Memorandum of Agreement on behalf of Quezon City Government with the Winning Circle Corporation, operating as LifeSkillsPH, represented by Ms. Cecile L. Ang, President, for the implementation of the LifeSkillsPH Program that will provide technical and vocational courses in Quezon City University (QCU).

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution be furnished to LifeSkillsPH President Cecille L. Ang and DOST-NCR Regional Director Romelen T. Tresvalles for their information and guidance.
