

WHEREAS, in 1997, the Quezon City Council enacted Ordinance No. SP-572, S-97, otherwise known as "The Quezon City Child and Youth Welfare Ordinance." It is a landmark legislation which aims to ensure the children's development, survival, protection, and participation;

WHEREAS, with awareness of the risks and early signs of special needs, parents will be equipped and knowledgeable of the early intervention programs and services for the benefit of their children;

WHEREAS, to also cater to the parents who are expecting the early intervention seminar will be initiated by the barangays in Quezon City at least once every quarter;

WHEREAS, to streamline the process, barangays are given the responsibility of referring parents of children with special needs to the appropriate departments where specific programs and services are provided or tailored to the individual needs of each child;

WHEREAS, all departments, whether public or private, are urged to collaborate and work together towards the goal of promoting awareness and early intervention for children with special needs;

WHEREAS, the early intervention seminar, as initiated by the barangays, may be done in collaboration with the public and private schools in Quezon City offering special intervention programs and services.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to strongly urge, as it does hereby strongly urge, barangays to conduct a seminar for pregnant parents and parents of newborns or toddlers regarding early intervention for children with special needs.
