RESOLUTION NO. SP- **9603**, S-2024

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE MAYOR OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF RODRIGUEZ, HONORABLE RONNIE S. EVANGELISTA, FOR THE ACCEPTANCE AND RECEIVING OF THE INFORMAL SETTLER FAMILIES (ISFS)-RELOCATEES FROM QUEZON CITY, THE 10% ALLOCATION OF ISFS FROM RODRIGUEZ, RIZAL TO THE TOTAL OFF-CITY HOUSING UNITS DEVELOPED BY BAQUE CORPORATION IN BARANGAY SAN ISIDRO, RODRIGUEZ, RIZAL, AND THE GRANT OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FUND OF PHP10,000,000.00 TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF RODRIGUEZ

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Quezon City entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with Baque Corporation, a National Housing Authority-accredited private housing developer, for the development and direct acquisition of 1,000 off-City housing units, intended for the relocation of Informal Settler Families (ISFs) in Quezon City who will be affected by the implementation of its infrastructure and housing projects, court and administrative orders of demolition, and those occupying danger areas other than waterways;

WHEREAS, at least 546 housing units are now being developed and constructed within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Rodriguez, Rizal, particularly near Aylon Zoo and Sitio Maislap in Barangay San Isidro;

WHEREAS, LGU-Rodriguez, will have an allocation of 40 units from the total number of housing units being developed and constructed within the Municipality of Rodriguez, Rizal, for its ISFs constituents. LGU-Rodriguez, the receiving LGU, shall also welcome the grant of any financial support/assistance from the sending LGU;

WHEREAS, after due consideration, LGU-QC has agreed to allocate the 40 housing units from the total number of the off-City housing units being developed and constructed in Rodriguez, Rizal, to the ISFs of the said municipality, as well as the granting of financial assistance fund of Php10,000,000.00 to the Municipality of Rodriguez, Rizal, which shall be utilized to finance the basic services requirements of the ISFs-relocatees from Quezon City;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455(b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991," the City Mayor shall represent the city in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Mayor of the Municipality of Rodriguez, Honorable Ronnie S. Evangelista, for the acceptance and receiving of the Informal Settler Families (ISFs)-relocatees from Quezon City, the 10% allocation of ISFs from Rodriguez, Rizal to the total off-City housing units developed by Baque Corporation in Barangay San Isidro, Rodriguez, Rizal, and the grant of financial assistance fund of Php10,000,000.00 to the Municipality of Rodriguez.
