A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE OF EXCEPTION TO SPOUSES MARK N. SCHWAB AND VILMA LIBRE SCHWAB, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A 1-STOREY RESOURCE RECOVERY FACILITY AND INDUSTRIAL WAREHOUSE BUILDING WITH MEZZANINE (AS BUILT) LOCATED AT LOTS 4, 5, 6, 7, 12, 13, 14 AND 15, BLOCK 4, G. DE LEON STREET, BARANGAY SAUYO, DISTRICT VI, QUEZON CITY, ALLOWING DEVIATION FROM THE RESTRICTIONS PROVIDED UNDER ORDINANCE NO. SP-2502, S-2016, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE OF 2016

WHEREAS, Spouses Mark N. Schwab and Vilma Libre Schwab, are applying for the issuance of a Certificate of Exception for the construction and operation of a 1-Storey Resource Recovery Facility and Industrial Warehouse Building with Mezzanine (As Built) located at Lots 4, 5, 6, 7, 12, 13, 14 and 15, Block 4, G. De Leon Street, Barangay Sauyo, District VI, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Section 17, Article V, Section 55, Article VIII, and Section 73, Article IX, of Ordinance No. SP-2502, S-2016, an Exception is required for the aforesaid Project which will be issued only upon authorization by the City Council through a Resolution;

WHEREAS, the Proposed Project has complied with all the necessary requirements for the issuance of a Certificate of Exception as mandated by the Quezon City Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 2016.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the issuance of a Certificate of Exception to Spouses Mark N. Schwab and Vilma Libre Schwab, for the construction and operation of a 1-Storey Resource Recovery Facility and Industrial Warehouse Building with Mezzanine (As Built) located at Lots 4, 5, 6, 7, 12, 13, 14 and 15, Block 4, G. De Leon Street, Barangay Sauyo, District VI, Quezon City, allowing deviation from the restrictions provided under Ordinance No. SP-2502, S-2016, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 2016.
